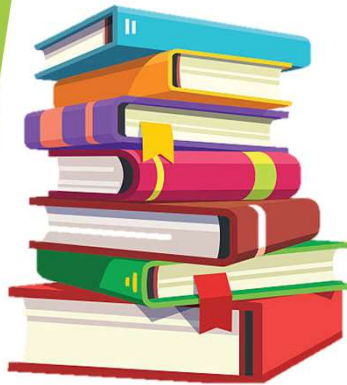


# Year 4 Welcome Time
