# Summer 1

## History and Geography

This term we will be having a cross curricular approach to history and geography as the pupils explore the local area looking at the location of Reading and what benefits that brings to the town also the history of the town and how it has changed and grown over time.

## PE

### Gymnastics – Tuesday
